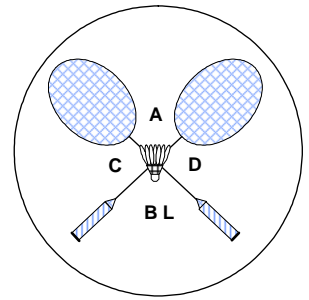


Aldershot & Camberley District District Badminton League Newsletter No.2

AND FINALLY

A plea from Phil, League Match Secretary. Please ensure all team captains are aware of the correct method of completing match cards.

- The full title of the team needs to be inserted, including whether it is the A or B team etc.
- Full names are required to avoid any confusion.
- If the home team win the game then H needs to be used. If the away team win the game then A is used. If the game is a draw then insert a D.
- The overall score with the name of the winning team is also required on the card.
- Please check that both teams have signed it and the winning team needs to send it in, if the match is drawn then the home team sends it in.
